CCS AUDAX RIDES FROM BILDESTON, REVISED DATE - SATURDAY 18 JULY

If you've not ridden an audax before, why not give it a go? Ride at your own pace, or with a group of friends; generous time limits, and built-in refreshment opportunities – what's not to like?

100, 160, 200k Suffolk rides, run by Andy Rogers on behalf of Cycle Club Sudbury, from Bildeston Sportsfield. A choice of three routes, all on quiet roads through the best bits of Suffolk. GPX routes available for all rides. Refreshments available at start and finish, café stops en route. If travelling from Sudbury, Bildeston High Street should be closed to traffic from the south, so the best route is

probably Lavenham Brettenham Hitcham Bildeston.

The rides are open to all, entry via the AudaxUK website at <https://www.audax.uk/choose-a-ride/calendar-events/> (website requires registration to enter, but no payment other than for the ride).

It would be good to see a number of CCS riders take part to support Andy's running of these rides. If travelling from Sudbury, Bildeston High Street should be closed to traffic (not bikes) from the south, so the best route is probably Lavenham Brettenham Hitcham Bildeston.

Suffolk Lanes Extravaganza, 209k; 8am

This route heads north from Bildeston to Walsham le Willows, then east through Eye to Halesworth, before turning south-east past Snape and on to the coast at Orford. The return route is via Wickham Market, Framlingham, Debenham and Needham Market. The route mainly uses country lanes with short stretches of minor A and B-road.

'100 Miles of Suffolk Lanes', 168k; 8.30am

This route heads north from Bildeston to near Walsham le Willows, then east to Framlingham (castle), and on to the coast at Orford (castle), returning via Wickham Market, Debenham, and Needham Market. The route mainly uses country lanes with short stretches of minor A and B-road.

'Bildeston Lanes' 103k; 9am

The route is broadly circular, starting south-east from Bildeston to Flowton, then north to Needham Market, Stowupland, continuing north to Cotton. The route then returns south to Buxhall, before zig-zagging back to Bildeston. There are few hills (a short, sharp one to warm you up after 2k!) on the route, which mainly uses country lanes with short stretches of minor A and B-roads.

SATURDAY 25 JULY – THE DUNWICH DYNAMO

Each year a number of CCS riders do this overnight ride, from Hackney, through Sudbury, to Dunwich. The complete ride is 112 miles, but if you find that daunting there's the option of joining at Sudbury.

SUNDAY 16 AUGUST CCS 5TH ANNUAL CYCLE TO HARWICH/ MANNINGTREE AND BACK TO HENNY SWAN

4 Summer Event Routes to choose from;

CCSudbury will be holding our fourth summer event, a morning cycle to Manningtree or Harwich returning to Henny Swan for approx 1.00pm and then lunch at 1.30pm. Ride leaders to be confirmed, please let me know if you can lead a ride.

The club partially subsidises the event and hence food costs just **£10.00 for our members and members get a drink on the club. Food choices need to be made in advance, see attached below, and emailed to rob.ev.jack@gmail.com**. Partners welcome at the lunch but if not CCS members food will cost £16.00.

Payment for the event can be made directly into our account CC Sudbury, account No. 30308188, Sort Code 20-83-50, please make the reference your name and CCSSE.

Short Sensibly paced route - 35 miles - Start at Homebase 9.00

Find route with the following link <https://ridewithgps.com/routes/43864709> details of the route for the social (sensible paced) ride on the 20th. It is 35 miles starting at Homebase with a refreshment stop at Dedham. This should ensure that we will finish at Henny Swan at 13.00 hours.

Slower paced route to Harwich, 65 miles - Start at Homebase 8.15

Starting from the roundabout at the back of Homebase, start time 8:15am, the same as last year. The ride will be at the speed of the slowest rider, I will be aiming for 12 to 13 mph average, I was surprised to find we rode at an average of 14 mph last year. Will have a refreshment stop just before the turn round in Harwich at The Café on the Green. Food is at 1.30 this year at Henny Swan allowing a little more time.

Medium paced route - 65 miles - Leader Start at Homebase 8.30

The ride will also start at Homebase and stop at the Cafe On The Pier in Harwich. Starting at 08.30 with an average speed of 15-16 mph and we start and finish together at the cafe and the Henny Swan. Route link below:-

Medium Fast paced route, 17-18 mph - 65 miles - Leader Rob Davies, Start at Homebase car park at 8.45

The ride will also start at Homebase and stop at the Cafe On The Pier in Harwich. Starting at 08.30 with an average speed of 18 mph and we start and finish together at the cafe and the Henny Swan. Route link below:-

Plus, maybe these scorching temps have discouraged riders to get out which is understandable 🤖 along with members moving away from the area or changing clubs.

Although one member has continued to send through his results despite now residing in Devon. I speak of Ian Short who is still active in the Devon TT scene and is still representing our club. Not surprisingly his times are not what I expect from Ian although the reason is probably in the area he is TT-ing in. Devon! Known for its hilly terrain, times are bound to suffer although some of times are surprisingly quick. Well done to him for continuing to send me his reports and for flying our club flag from afar!

Our other main protagonist on the TT scene is David Fenn who continues to defy his years and represent us in the East Anglian flat lands (although often not as we know as flat as other folk think) His times as consistent as ever and often near to his PB's which says it all. Our final rider is Simon Daw who has already recorded a very good time for a 100- mile TT, a shade over 4hrs, which I expect to be followed up with a 50mile TT soon to be eligible for the BAR end of season cup (25/50/100) as he has already ridden a fast 25 time this year.
